



The Pharmaceutical Process Analytics Roundtable (PPAR) is an annual meeting of practitioners of Process Analytical Technology (PAT) in the pharmaceutical and biotechnology industries.

The meeting provides a chance to interact with other colleagues, discuss best practices, learn of new technologies, and identify common needs. PPAR is not a standard conference, but is instead an interactive, informal discussion of the current state and future direction of PAT. The roundtable forum gives a group of approximately 30 participants the opportunity to discuss these important topics in a more informal environment than is generally encountered at conferences. There are no formal presentations, although participants may be asked to give a short topic introduction to kick off various discussion sessions.

 - consultants
